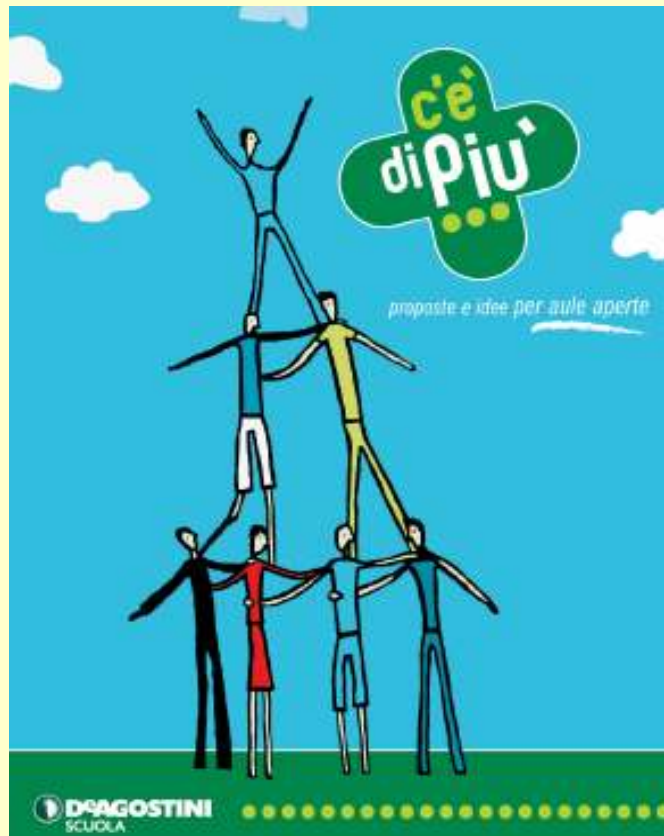

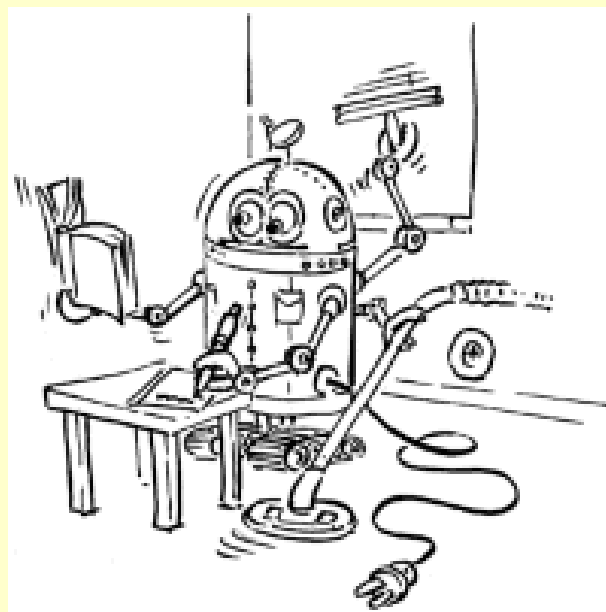

Yes, the jar is now full

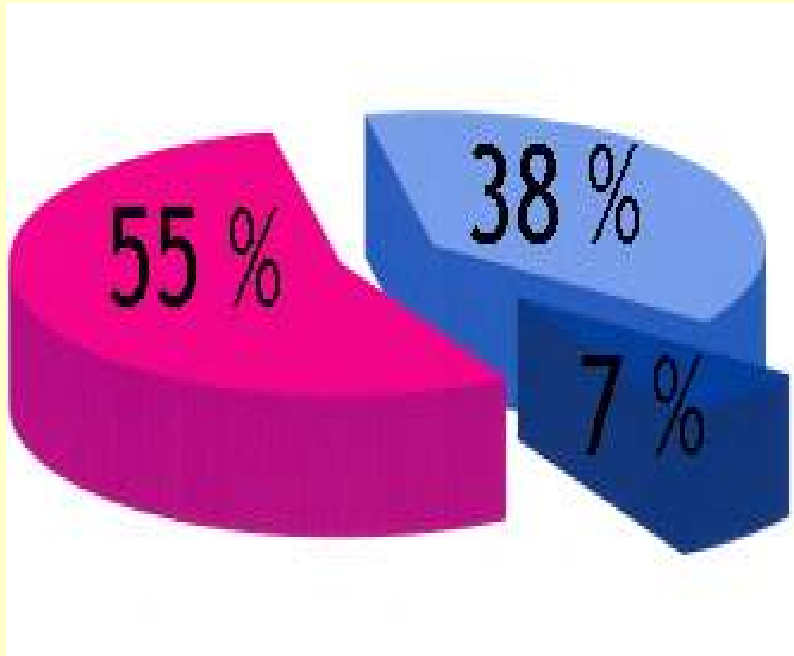


Multiple- response Warm-up

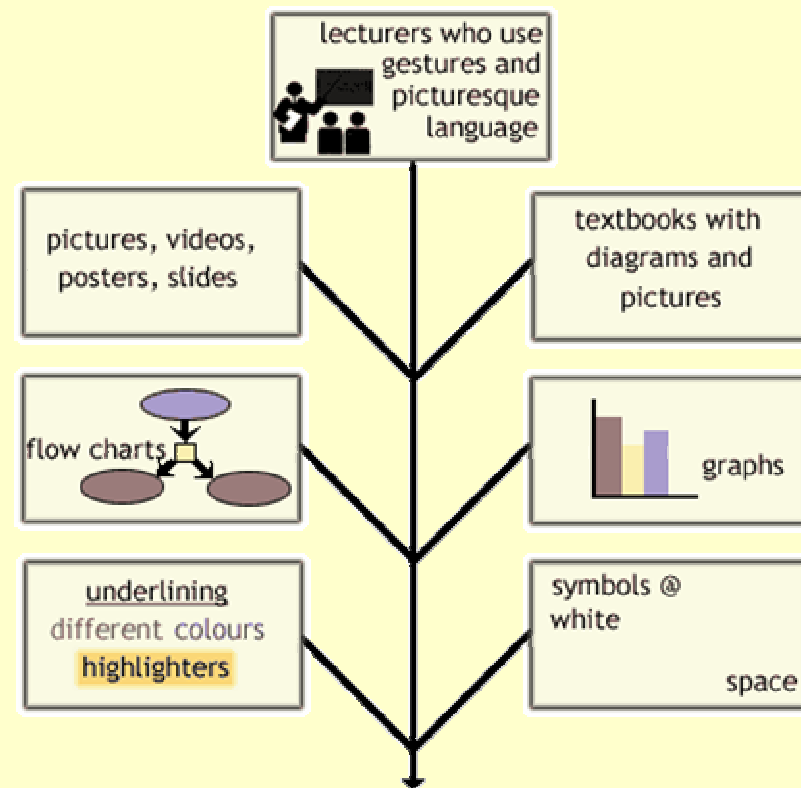
How do we learn?
